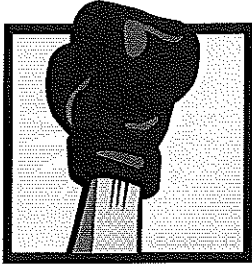

# DISCIPLESHIP

Jesus declared that the devil is a thief: *"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."* (John 10:10) One of the things the devil steals is words. Political correctness now demands that we refer to homosexuals as gays. In my early years, being gay meant to have a pleasant disposition, or to be happy.

Several years ago there was a movement called "The Discipleship Movement." In the name of "Discipleship" Christian leaders abused the authority God had given them and began using authority that God had not given them over the people. Many people with a strong temperamental need to be cared for were attracted to these so-called "shepherds" and the results were devastating. The harm done in this movement was not limited to those victims. Christians became so wary of the word "discipleship" that the very mention of the word brought a negative reaction. We must not, however, allow this perversion of the word, discipleship, to distract us from its legitimate meaning.

The "Great Commission" that the Lord gave all of His disciples, in every age, includes the imperative to disciple: *And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."* (Matthew 28:18-19) The Greek word translated, disciple, appears 269 times in the New Testament. It is defined as a *learner, pupil, disciple*. If a disciple is a learner, then the one who discipled is a teacher. Does this mean that everyone who discipled is someone gifted and called to be a teacher? No! The Word tells us that we are all to be disciples as well as disciplers.

Discipleship is largely one on one. Before Ford Motor Company could make thousands of cars a year, they first had to make one. We must learn how to make one disciple before we can make many. Our discipling is not to be for our local church, but for Jesus. A disciple is one who is reconciled to God. Paul tells us that we have been given the ministry of reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:18) Reconciliation means "restoration to favor" or "adjustment of a difference." When we are reconciled, we are restored to favor with God.

An emotional response to a message in word or song that doesn't change your commitment is not becoming a disciple. Saying a prayer, then resting upon that act, expecting to go to heaven when you die, is not becoming a disciple of the Lord. A disciple desires to be like Jesus. A true disciple will want to emulate Jesus' character and values. Many who claim to be disciples only want His power. Jesus walked in total submission to God, and that is what a true disciple will do. A disciple wants to know Jesus relationally, not just know about Him. This involves spending time with Him--going where He goes and yielding to His leadership--knowing that you will learn of Him on the journey.

The disciple will follow Jesus, not just try to find things to do to please Him. The emphasis will be on relationship. A disciple is one who has embraced the Kingdom of God. This means that God rules in his life. The disciple lives according to the values of the Kingdom. There is a cost to discipleship. In his book, Mere Christianity, C.S. Lewis wrote that, "To many people Christian living is taking the natural self, adding good behavior and subtracting bad behavior." This is how we tend to approach the Christian experience, but a true disciple gives up his rights to retain self as a separate entity. The Kingdom of God has first priority for a true disciple.
